

### **Unoiled Fisheries Claim Award Estimates:**

There are 34 different fisheries in the unoiled fish claim category for which claims have been filed. It is impossible to provide exact amounts that claimants will receive in any of the fisheries because Final Percent Share (FPS) numbers may change if claimants file objections and their appeals are successful, and as claimants perfect their claims. Thus, all numbers in this note are fluid. The chart linked to below shows FPS share values and their approximate gross value. The Target Allocation includes Supplemental, Compensatory Damages, Compensatory Interest, Punitive Damages, and Punitive Interest. Your FPS was reported on page 5 of your Final Percent Share Report which was mailed on October 21st, 2009. From that amount 22.4% is deducted for court approved attorneys' fees.

It is important to emphasize that these figures are for people who did NOT participate in the Alyeska Qualified Settlement Fund (AQSF) distribution that occurred in 2009. Of the approximate 8,000 EQSF claimants in the unoiled fishery category, about 2,600 participated in the AQSF and received a recovery. If a claimant did get money from the AQSF, it will reduce the amount they will get from the EQSF.

In addition, there are about 38 claimants who brought individual actions against Exxon whose cases were dismissed. Those are called "Allen plaintiffs" and the value of their claim is reduced by 50% under the Court's orders. Their FPS number reflects this modification.
